Women at the Heart of Peace and Reconciliation

This is the focus for 2017-18 Development & Peace Women play a key role in conflict prevention and resolution, as well as building and sustaining an inclusive, lasting and fair peace.

- Out of the 504 peace agreements signed since 2000 only 138 or 27% mention women
- Of the major peace negotiations that took place between 1992 and 2011 only 2% of chief mediators, 4% of signatories and 9% of negotiators were women
- Only 2% of international funding dedicated to peace and security is allocated to equality between women and men or the empowerment of women. Given the increasing number of violent conflicts and their dramatic repercussions on civilians, we must find new solutions to promoting peace.
