This collection was originally organized to assist with the support of the Christian Holy places and facilities for pilgrims in the Holy Land. Over the years, the needs have expanded to include projects with other Christian Churches, those in cooperation with Jews and Muslims, and to provide support for the local Christian communities. Much of this work is entrusted to the Custody of the Holy Land which has been under the direction of the Franciscans of the Order of Friars Minor since the 13th century. This collection is “not only for the Holy Places but above all for those pastoral, charitable, educational, and social works which the Church supports in the Holy Land for the welfare of their Christian brethren and of the local communities.”
