Sacramental Information

Baptism: at Our Lady Queen of Peace you must call the office at least 3 months in advance to arrange an appointment with the Pastor. It is assumed that the family has Our Lady Queen of Peace parish connection and practices the faith by attending Sunday Mass on a weekly basis. You may meet with the Pastor and take the course even if your child has not yet been born. Parents are expected to participate in the Baptismal preparation. At least one Godparent or both must be baptized and confirmed and are practicing Catholics. Non-parishioners are required to have a Letter of Recommendation from your Pastor to have your child Baptized in our parish.

Marriage: at Our Lady Queen of Peace because the Church is deeply concerned about each marriage, couples are asked to give a minimum of six months' notice prior to the intended date of their wedding. Church policy requires that marriages be performed in your home parish – unless you are registered and attend elsewhere.

<u>Funeral:</u> at Our Lady Queen of Peace individual arrangements with a priest. Begin by calling the parish office.

September 1 was proclaimed as the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation for the Eastern Orthodox Church by Ecumenical Patriarch Dimitrios I in 1989. This day was embraced by Pope Francis in 2015, the year his Encyclical "Laudato Si" was published. **The Season of Creation runs from September 1 to October 4,** the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi, the author of the Canticle of the Creatures, and the Patron Saint of those who promote ecology. This year's theme is "Listen to the Voice of Creation", an opportunity to centre our prayers and actions for the individuals, communities, species and ecosystems that have been severely affected by climate change and habitat loss.
