Baptism at Our Lady Queen of Peace

A disaster like no other

The Philippines is one of the most disaster-prone countries in the world and it has seen its share of typhoons – but nothing like super Typhoon Haiyan. The strongest storm on record to make landfall, super Typhoon Haiyan surged through a wide path of destruction that included some of the poorest parts of the Philippines.

Its deadly winds swept away villages, leaving houses in tatters, trees uprooted, roads covered in heavy debris and families separated.

An estimated **9 million** people are affected by this storm and many people are staying in open areas without shelter.

Comparisons are being made to the amount of devastation caused by the 2004 Tsunami – and some fear it could be worse.

The Philippines needs your solidarity

Bishop Richard writes:

"Our prayers go out to all the victims of Typhoon Haiyan and our hearts are mindful of the Filipino community in the Diocese of Victoria whose country now struggles to come to terms with this tragedy. I ask for continued prayers for those who have died, for those injured, the many who have suffered loss, the homeless and all who have been affected by this disaster." The Bishop further indicates that a special collection will be held on the weekend of Nov. 23 / 24 to assist the victims of this typhoon. All funds will be directed to D & P which is working with Caritas International. If you have not had an opportunity to donate directly then this will be an opportunity to reach out to assist. The Filipino priests within the diocese will be offering a special Mass for those who have died in the Philippines on Wed., Nov. 20th at 7 p.m. at Sacred Heart Church.
