Development & Peace - A Voice for Justice

As your representative for Development and Peace I have great pleasure in telling you about a campaign called A Voice for Justice, that doesn't ask for your money!!! Over the next few bulletins I want to tell you the background for a human rights issue. I will (in the new year) ask you, after considering the information I can give, and further research that you may do on your own, to send a post card we will provide. The postcard will ask the Government of Canada to appoint an Ombudsperson to bring the concerns of people in other countries regarding Canadian mining companies to our government.

A Voice for Justice is in response to reports from mine-affected communities in Africa, Asia and Latin America that are experiencing conflict, pollution, forced displacements and other negative impacts from the presence of Canadian mines. It calls on the Government of Canada to establish an independent ombudsman for the Canadian extractive sector that can investigate complaints brought by communities overseas where companies operate.
