Baptism at Our Lady Queen of Peace

To have your child Baptized at Our Lady Queen of Peace Church, you must **call the office at least 3 months in advance to arrange an appointment with the Pastor.** It is assumed that the family has Our Lady Queen of Peace parish connection and practices the faith by attending Sunday Mass on a weekly basis. You may meet with the Pastor and take the course even if your child has not yet been born. **Parents are expected to participate in the Baptismal preparation.** At least one Godparent or both must be baptized and confirmed and are practicing Catholics. **Non-parishioners are required to have a Letter of Recommendation from your Pastor to have your child Baptized in our parish.**

PASTOR'S CORNER

The Parable of the good Samaritan may be the most famous story Jesus ever told. His hearers would have understood its meaning on many different levels, an indictment of racial prejudice, a condemnation of empty faith, a motivation of practical love. But let's focus on the perspective: the journey that we all share. All of us are on the way "from Jerusalem to Jericho." All of us have been robbed and beaten by the Fall and left half dead. And all of us have walked by one another, crossing over to the other side. But sometimes we take a risk. Sometimes we reach out to one another, not knowing for sure if our offers to help will even be accepted. We give what we have because that's all we can give. The amazing thing is not so much we help but what God does with our help. There at the Inn, the patient recovered. He didn't die. Simply by stopping, by caring, by doing what we know how to do, we saved a life. Our world and eternity will never be the same.
