Father André Dion (RIP) - 1923 - 2016

Your prayers are requested for Father André Dion who passed away peacefully after a short illness, on August 1, 2016. The Funeral Mass will be celebrated on **Tuesday, August 9, 2016 at 11:30 am at St. Andrew's Cathedral,** with interment at Ross Bay cemetery.

André Dion was born in in Montmagny, Quebec, on October 17, 1923, the sixth child in the family. Within six months, André's mother travelled with the family to New Hampshire, to re-unite with her husband, and so that they could pursue a livelihood in the lumber industry in the Northeast. However, there were no Catholic schools in the region, so the family returned to Canada six years after leaving.

He received Officer's Training in Three Rivers, Quebec, from 1938 – 1944, and used skills to fill a variety of roles, teacher, accountant, photographer, writer, and tech wizard Despite the attractions of the secular world, André was drawn to the monastic life, and answered a call to enter the Franciscan Novitiate in 1944. He worked and studied, diligently, receiving a Bachelor of Arts and Sciences from Laval University in 1948, then going on to study theology in both Montreal and Edmonton, and act as an instructor at the college level. He was ordained to the priesthood in Montreal in June, 1953.

About the same time, Father Dion began to respond to a need to learn more and do more in his second language, English. As a result, his journey across Canada began, with studies in Edmonton, and then assignment to one of British Columbia's bi-lingual communities, Maillardville (Coquitlam). In 1962, he was transferred to Port Alberni, BC where he served until being called to leadership in his Franciscan community.

After four years in leadership, Father Dion returned to the Diocese of Victoria, taking up duties as a 'priestworker' in the North island parishes of Port Hardy, Port Alice and Port McNeill from 1968 - 1978. Immediately after that placement, Father Dion responded to the call of his Bishop, Remi De Roo, to take a study sabbatical and to review the nature of 'charismatic renewal' in Canada and the US. Upon his return, Father Dion was incardinated as a priest in the diocese, and went immediately to serve at Victoria's Ste.-Jean Baptise parish. In 1984, Father André Dion accepted a post at Sooke, BC, and acted, concurrently, as the chaplain at Willian Head Institution. In the late 1980's, Father Dion returned to downtown Victoria, serving as assistant at St. Andrew's Cathedral, and chaplain to St. Ann's Residence. In one last call to parish service, he completed his career at Trinity in Nanaimo, and retired in June of 1993, back to the city of Victoria, yet still in the service of the faithful when called upon.

Father André Dion passed away peacefully in Victoria, BC on August 1, 2016, after 92 years of life filled with wonder.
