Baptism at Our Lady Queen of Peace

To have your child Baptized at Our Lady Queen of Peace Church, you must **call the office at least 3 months in advance to arrange an appointment with the Pastor.** It is assumed that the family has Our Lady Queen of Peace parish connection and practices the faith by attending Sunday Mass on a weekly basis. You may meet with the Pastor and take the course even if your child has not yet been born. **Parents are expected to participate in the Baptismal preparation.** At least one Godparent or both must be baptized and confirmed and are practicing Catholics. **Non-parishioners are required to have a Letter of Recommendation from your Pastor to have your child Baptized in our parish.**

Women at the Heart of Peace and Reconciliation

This is the focus for 2017-18 Development & Peace Women play a key role in conflict prevention and resolution, as well as building and sustaining an inclusive, lasting and fair peace. - Out of the 504 peace agreements signed since 2000 only 138 or 27% mention women - Of the major peace negotiations that took place between 1992 and 2011 only 2% of chief mediators, 4% of signatories and 9% of negotiators were women - Only 2% of international funding dedicated to peace and security is allocated to equality between women and men or the empowerment of women. Given the increasing number of violent conflicts and their dramatic repercussions on civilians, we must find new solutions to promoting peace.
